Position Overview

Reporting to the Head Pro, you will deliver club-organized clinics as well as private, semi-private and group lessons to members and guests of all ages and levels of play. You will work closely with the club pro as well as other staff members to ensure an exceptional experience for our members, campers and guests. You will have a visible presence at the club supporting KTC's mission as a high-quality club, bringing together a community of people who love tennis.



Duties and Responsibilities

- Support the Head Pro as an instructor for many of the KTC-organized clinics for adult and junior players.
- As assigned, deliver private and semi-private lessons, and group lessons.
- Assist as necessary in the organization and running of tournaments and other club tennis events, including the Junior Tennis Tournament, Family Tennis Fest, and Open House.
- With the Head Pro, provide training and curriculum support to other instructors (including camp counsellors).
- Collaborate with Conor Casey and the KTC on social media content, branding, and marketing strategies.
- Provide a high level of service to members and guests and be responsive to their inquiries
- Support the Head Pro, on and off the court, in other ways as assigned, including programming, content creation, social media, and administrative support.
- Average expected workload over the season is 25-35 hours per week, including weekends; variable week to week depending on demand and club activities
